
SNB ROAD TEST APPOINTMENT

CLIENTS POSSESSING A FOREIGN COUNTRY LICENCE

Congratulations, you have passed the first step in obtaining a New Brunswick Driver's Licence. The next step is to pass a road test. To be eligible to complete your road test, you must exchange your home country license prior to your appointment. This must be completed within 6 months from successfully completing the written test or you will be required to redo the written and vision test.

If you have not yet exchanged your foreign license, you must arrive at least 45 minutes prior to your road test appointment to process your exchange and pay all required fees: up to \$90.00 for the New Brunswick driver license and \$25.00 + HST for the road test fee.

You must bring with you the following to exchange your licence:

- Your original home country licence and an official translation of your licence (if not in English or French) or an International Driver's Permit.
- Original identity document and 2 proofs of residency – see [Identification document handout](#) and [Proof of residency handout](#)

If you have already exchanged your foreign licence, you must arrive at least 20 minutes prior to your road test appointment to pay the test fee of \$25.00 + HST.

You **must** bring with you the following for your road test:

- The valid, signed motor vehicle registration and valid insurance card for the vehicle that you are using for the road test. If you are using a rental vehicle, then the Rental Agreement must include your name on it. *Please ensure that the Rental Agreement (Terms and Conditions) does not state that the vehicle cannot be used for road testing purpose*
- Your receipt as proof of payment for your road test
- Your NB class 7-1 or 7-1* licence

If you are successful in passing the road test, a New Brunswick Class 5 licence will be issued the same day.

OR

If you are not successful in passing the road test you will retain your New Brunswick Level 7-1/7-1* learner's licence.

- **This means you will only be able to drive with one other person who is a fully licensed driver, until the road test is passed.** You will be required book another appointment and to pay another fee of \$25.00 + HST to take the road test again.
